1. Information We Collect

2. How We Use Your Information

3. Text Message (SMS) Policy

Message Frequency: Message frequency varies based on appointment activity.

Message & Data Rates: Message and data rates may apply depending on your carrier plan.

Help & Opt-Out: Text HELP for assistance or STOP to opt out at any time.

Privacy Protection: Your mobile phone number and SMS opt-in data will never be shared, sold, or disclosed to third parties. All messages are used solely for communication related to Crossroads Pediatrics services.

4. Information Sharing

We do not sell, trade, or share your personal or mobile information with outside parties, except as required by law or when necessary to provide care (for example, with insurance providers, laboratories, or healthcare partners directly involved in your child's treatment).

5. Data Sharing

- Customer data is not shared with third parties for promotional or marketing purposes.
- Mobile opt-in and consent information are never shared with anyone for any purpose.
- Any information sharing that may be mentioned elsewhere in this policy excludes mobile opt-in data, which remains confidential and protected.

6. Data Security

We follow HIPAA and industry standards to secure your data through encryption, secure servers, and

access controls. Only authorized staff have access to patient information.

7. Messaging Terms and Conditions
